



INAUGURAL FRANCES P. JORDON MEMORIAL GOLF TOURNAMENT

(Charleston, WV) – Each year, The First Tee of West Virginia holds several premier fundraising and community events to aid in serving the ever-growing number of participants.

The first fundraiser of the year is scheduled for Friday, April 14, 2017 at Big Bend Golf Course in Tornado, WV. The event will be played in a scramble format and golfers can register in advance as a full foursome or as an individual player. The event will begin at 9:00am. The registration fee of \$75 per player will cover 18-holes of golf with a cart, lunch, beverages on course and awards following the tournament. All proceeds from the event will help fund the future plans for the Frances P. Jordon Golf Learning Center at Coonskin Park.

Frances P. Jordon Golf Learning Center officially opened on April 9, 2011. The 28-acre golf facility has 60x100 natural Bermuda Tee Box, six target greens and state of the art Fiberbuilt Synthetic Turf for inclement weather and winter usage. The facility is the largest public range in the state of WV, is one of the most used facilities in the Kanawha County Park Facilities and currently serves as one of the programming locations of The First Tee of West Virginia. Future plans include covering the synthetic hitting area and adding a short game area complete with putting green, bunker and chipping areas.
