CELEBRATE AMERICA'S BIRTHDAY AT AMERICA'S RESORT WITH THE FIRST TEE OF WEST VIRGINIA



(Charleston, WV) – The Greenbrier Classic Youth Day presented by POLO Golf will take place on Tuesday, July 4th with assistance from both The First Tee of West Virginia and The First Tee of Roanoke Valley. Activities will be held throughout the day to involve the youth who make up the future of the game of golf.

The Youth Day activities on July 4 begin at 11:00am with a private luncheon celebrating all of the accomplishments of the organization and its participants. The luncheon will be held at The Greenbrier and will include a buffet luncheon along with a 6-hole mini golf challenge. All in attendance will also have the opportunity to hear from Mr. Lee Trevino, The Greenbrier’s Golf Professional Emeritus and a surprise PGA TOUR Professional.

Youth Day will continue at 1:00PM on the Fairway of #18 Greenbrier, with interactive games and activities for youth of all ages. All youth will receive special gifts from The First Tee of West Virginia and POLO Golf. Additionally, the first 150 youth will receive a logoed autograph flag to collect autographs of PGA TOUR Professionals throughout the week. Certified coaches from both The First Tee organizations will be on hand to provide instruction designed to keep youth active and engaged for a fun and memorable experience.

At 2:00PM, the day will continue with a short-game clinic on the Green of #18 Greenbrier followed by a Full Swing clinic on the Tee of #1 Greenbrier. All youth and their families are encouraged to watch and learn from the PGA TOUR Professionals on-hand.

Rounding out the afternoon, at 3:30PM, the POLO Golf Scramble will pair Alex Kagan and Mary Denny from the First Tee of West Virginia, and John Hatcher Ferguson and Andrew Withers from the First Tee of Roanoke Valley, with two PGA TOUR professionals who are sponsored by POLO Golf. The teams will play holes 1, 11 and 18 on the Old White TPC. All in attendance are encouraged to follow the group as they compete for a \$10,000 prize for their Chapter.

“Youth Day at The Greenbrier Classic is such a tremendous opportunity for The First Tee of West Virginia to engage with youth from across the state,” says Ashley Hamilton, Director of The First Tee of West Virginia. “Once we have a chance to engage and an interest is sparked, with the help of their families, we can begin to instill the Nine Core Values that the The First Tee is built upon.
